

2 WORK HEALTH, SAFETY AND ENVIRONMENT

2.1 Work Health, Safety and Environment Policy Statement

CAS considers the safety and health of its employees and the protection of the environment to be of great importance and an integral part of the day-to-day management of its business. CAS's policy is to provide a safe and healthy workplace, as far as reasonably practicable, and to minimise its impacts on the environment.

To achieve this policy CAS will undertake the following:

- (a) Integrate safety, health and environmental considerations into all aspects of its day to day management of its activities
- (b) Use a risk assessment and management approach to identify and manage its potential hazards and impacts
- (c) Promote safety, health and environmental awareness amongst its employees by:
 - (i) providing appropriate training
 - (ii) providing feedback on all incidents
 - (iii) encouraging employee participation in safety, health and environmental issues
- (d) Conduct inspections and other activities to ensure the identification of health, safety and environmental issues
- (e) Undertake appropriate investigation of all accidents and serious incidents and implement action plans to reduce risks
- (f) Comply with all relevant legislation and regulations governing its activities.
